

PROTECTED CODE BLUE/EMERGENT MEDICAL INTERVENTION

For: St. Johns Rehab, Holland Centre, CNIB and Reactivation Care Centre (Humber) and areas not served by Code Blue team at Bayview campus.

General guiding principles to reduce potential exposure to health care workers where it relates to aerosol-generating medical procedures (AGMP) with high consequence pathogens, include minimizing staff and equipment entering room and modifying processes where possible (e.g. implementation of a Safety Leader for donning and doffing).

This process map aims to identify procedures that are not within routine practice. The assumption is that all standards of care and best practice continue to be employed with the addition of these modifications (e.g. delivering oxygen via nasal prong to venturi mask as required with increasing oxygen demands).

Protected PPE: N95 mask, full face shield, routine isolation gown, one pair of gloves. Last Updated 2020/04/01.
